However, we then found out that the Aussie dollar will be adjusted and in order for us to go we need to be set to the revised dollar which took us back to 81% (Boo!), but could still change for the worst or better (should be set by the end of July). So while we are pretty disappointed about not being able to go, we are thankful for the delay in that there are a number of missionaries who are experiencing this while they are in the field and trying to figure out what to do, which at worst is coming home to raise more support to go back and at best is being able to raise the support from existing contacts while they are in the field .

PRAYER & PRAISE

- Praise God that people welcomed Scott and Janelle during their recent visit to a Khmer village. Pray for the discernment of the Holy Spirit as the team seeks to join with what God is doing in this new region of Cambodia and that there will be many opportunities to share the Gospel.
- Remember Phil in South Asia during the Ramadan season. Every evening there are times of community fellowship as local people break the fast together. Pray for Phil and other B believers as they spend time eating and sharing with these people. Pray that Christ would reveal Himself as they search for connection with God.
- Pray for Tim and Mel and their family as they return to Malawi today. Pray for quick healing of Mel's ankle, that was fractured over the weekend and that there are no further complications. Pray that as they return refreshed they will strengthen the group of Yawo believers and that many more would come to know Jesus.
- Pray that even in the midst of the Massangulo building project (which is strategically placed to reach more Yao villages), the team registration renewal (which has been an ongoing challenge) and culture and language learning (which is essential), the team in Mozambique would be aware of where God is at work in the everyday. Pray that they would be sensitive to where, in whom and how He is working and that He might be pleased to use them in sharing the Good News. Remember Sally as she shares her story and builds a group of supporters so that she can join the team.
- A team of 10 Australian Baptists are currently in Zambia teaching and doing practical work for NBAZ. They are led by our Global Consultant for Leadership Development – Roger Kemp and his wife Barbara. They are sharing their time between Fiwale Hill, Kabwe and Malambanyama. The teaching will be the launch of the new Advanced Leadership Training Programme of NBAZ which trains teachers to teach their own church leaders in a three year foundation course. Pray for good health, safe travel and good outcomes for the work, including the renovation of the guest house at Fiwale Hill.
