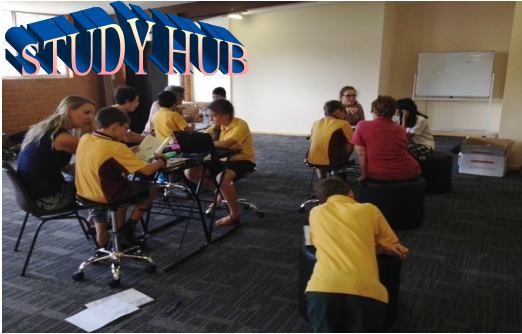

Pakistan

Asia Bibi remains in prison five years after she was sentenced to death under Pakistan's blasphemy laws. Asia is now waiting for a trial date to be set on her final appeal against the sentence, before the Supreme Court of Pakistan. Recently we heard an insight into what life is like for Asia in Multan Jail.

ALIVE, who Open Doors partners with in Pakistan told us Asia spends her days in solitary confinement and suffers from internal bleeding and poor health. The prison requires her and other prisoners to read the Quran every day. Prisoners are told that if they memorize a significant portion, their sentence will be reduced. She longs to be reunited with her family.

Extremely hot summer temperatures, combined with poor sanitation, ventilation and lighting, make conditions close to unbearable. In the block Asia is being held, nearly 150 inmates are squeezed into an area built for 30 or 40.

An ALIVE worker told us, "The question on most people's mind is: 'Why does God allow this to happen?' For me, the purpose is clear... she is a living example of the need to come to the Lord in prayer... We have been raising prayer support for Asia for many years and have been encouraging local Christians to take the lead in praying for their sister in prison."

Pray with us:
