### S.I PEOPLE

In June, **Andy and Wanda** will arrive in Australia for their Home Assignment. Their key ministries, the café and Creation Care project, will be run by local staff in their absence. Plans are being put in place to refurbish and rebrand the café later this year. The one year anniversary of the Creation Care project is approaching and Andy and Wanda are excited by the initiatives that are being planned. The new local director is settling into his role well along with other local staff.

### B PEOPLE

Sam has begun her culture and language lessons with a new language nurturer and they are relating well with each other. **Sally** has now been in Mozambique for a few months and is beginning to form some friendships with local people.
