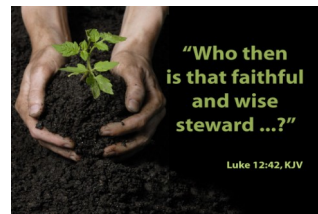

- YAWO: Praise God for Mr.S, the local village headman,as he has chosen to become a follower of Jesus. Ian and Wendy have been meeting with Mr. S for more than a year in Malawi and recently started to sense him moving towards Jesus. During one of these meetings together he told Ian and Wendy he is now putting his faith in God.Pray for Mr. S and Ian as he continues to disciple him and they work together to build a Bible study group in Mr. S's village. Pray that more Yawo people will come to know and have faith in Jesus.
- YAO: Tobias and Heather are still in Australia raising their final partnership support to return to Mozambique to continue to serve among the Yao. Pray that Tobias and Heather will be able to be in Lichinga in time for their visa renewal.
