I can remember that over a year ago now I was upstairs in the Church Hall when the idea of "Study Hub" first jumped into my head. It was like I saw the room repainted, furniture and the kids working together to learn. However it wasn't until Chester & Ann visited Kylie & I for our membership application that I first spoke about the idea. That idea turned into an opportunity and now a working vision that continues to grow! Late last year an opportunity arose for me to work at Ringrose Public School for 2015. Kylie & I both felt that in order for Study Hub to launch I needed to be working in the area, not 1 hour away. So I applied for the job and got it. But it was only for 3 days a week. The problem was, we needed me to work 5 days in order to pay our bills and to save enough for me to visit Brae & Harry in Denver. Only working 3 days would mean not seeing them for at least a year. Kylie & I talked and prayed about what I should do and realised that this was still the right move to take the new job, believing that God was working to get Study Hub up and running. Through this I can remember thinking about what Jesus said to his disciples in Mark's Gospel "No one who has left home or brothers or sisters... or children for me and the Gospel will fail to receive a hundred times as much..." This was clearly a test for us. Besides that, all things needed to fall into place. My school at Bæcroft had to be willing to let me take leave for a year and we had to have faith that God would provide somehow. My boss asked me at the time before she granted my leave if only 3 days work a week was enough. I said no. But it will be ok. When Rick asked me what I would do if I couldn't get the 2 extra days I needed for work I told him that I believed God had a plan. And God will not be

stopped. I just needed faith that things would work out. That Study Hub needed to happen. It wasn't until after I started work at Ringrose that I was offered 2 extra days work a week. What a blessing! Study Hub officially launched last week and continues to grow. New kids have come to every single session. And already more desks and chairs have been bought to handle the increase. Just yesterday, at school, I ran into a girl who attended Study Hub on Monday for the first time. She excitedly said to me, "Mr Stroud! I loved Homework Club! See you next Monday!" "Awesome!" I said. "See you then." And we both went on our way...
