

1. For the month of July we will be hearing from speakers both inside and outside of the church. Rick will be away for the 3 middle Sundays and so it is an opportune time to have others invest in teaching and speaking to what God has to show us through His Word. On Sunday the 2nd of July, Pastor Aris will be sharing a message with us and also sharing about his upcoming mission trip to the Philippines and how we might be involved. Please, if you feel led, come prepared to give financially to this work.
2. Having walked the 8 week journey through the Transformed series, today is our final Sunday message to complete the series. Next week will be an opportunity to celebrate how God has worked through His Word in this series through the testimonies of people's lives. Please be considering what you might be able to share, from how this series had benefited your life of following Jesus...both the struggles and successes and it's impact on real changes of mind, heart and action. This will be a celebration service that will lead into our AGM as a continuing celebration of what God is doing here in this local church. 3. After next weeks service we will be holding a celebration lunch together, please make every effort to be among your church family to share in this meal together. We will be christening our BBQ and Pizza Oven and thanking God for His faithfulness in helping transform our lives and our building to continue being useful to Himself and His Kingdom. If you're able to attend, those people whose last name starts with the letters A-K please bring a small salad to share and those from M-Z (whose name starts with a Z ????) please bring a small desert to share. 4. Over the months of August and September we will be working through a series aptly named, "Moving with the Spirit" (A Journey through Acts). During this time we will continue working in our weekday home groups with resources that point in the same direction. Over the month of July this series and the resources will be made available to each home group to discuss and clarify the direction they'll be heading in. Also during the month of July, small groups are encouraged to take some time out of the formalities of studying together and find times to celebrate life together over meals and perhaps even find a project or two they can do together, readying themselves to renew their minds and hearts as they study the Movement of the Holy Spirit over Aug. & Sept.
5. After much contemplation and discussion the leadership is looking to begin an evening service. Initially this will begin monthly on the opposing fortnight to Soul Food (night service on the 2nd Sunday of the month and Soul Food the 4th Sunday). Please be in prayer for this, as we see how God might lead us to give greater opportunity to people to come together in encouragement around His Word. The service at this stage will be held upstairs and start time will be a "majority vote", however at this point 5:30pm is the suggested start time, coinciding with our Soul Food start time. The intention is to begin our first night service Sunday August 13. Please begin having conversations with your friends and family as to how this could be of benefit to yourselves and the people you know. Also, please share any ideas you might have with the pastor, deacons or elders in informing how this might best serve our church family.

KHMER

Rob and Deb were invited to their first Khmer wedding in Cambodia, which they found to be a rich cultural experience. They were invited to join the celebrations by their landlord's family who are relatives of the bride. Rob and Deb interact with their landlord's family every day and attending the wedding has helped to further deepen their relationship with this Khmer family. Rob and Deb have begun their separate culture and language lessons with newly trained Khmer language nurturers.
