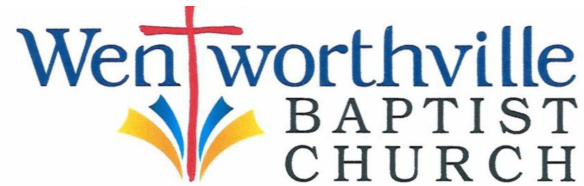

It wasn't always easy and we were really worried about Courtney and how she would go doing the HSC as she attended less than 20 days in Year 12, her final year of school. She also collapsed during an exam and failed to attend one, so we really worried that she would not be able to get sufficient marks to attend University. Well not only did God provide her with "Early Admission", to the exact course she was most interested in, He provided it at the Uni that was closest and easiest to get to so as to minimize her travel and energy. He truly is a great God and we know He is looking after us. Her battle is not over yet and already she has struggled but we know He has it in hand. Please keep Courtney in your prayers as she battles this condition and that we will have the patience and skills to respond in the correct way.
