

## **ETHIOPIA | YOUR SUPPORT GAVE HOPE!**

Sintayehu's church in <u>Ethiopia</u> was attacked in 2009, right after Ramadan. When her husband, Marcos, decided to help the church financially, he was killed by extremists. Two years later, her son Tekalign was left traumatised after he was in a motor accident which killed two people. And a few months after that, her other son Abush died in an explosion at work. Sintayehu was full of grief and had no means of providing for her family.

#### **GOD AT WORK**

Through your help, we have been able to support Sintayehu and her family for 7 years! Sintayehu was able to get trauma counselling at a seminar Open Doors ran for widows. Your support also helped her buy a house and open a restaurant, so Sintayehu is now able to provide for her family.

"I thank God." She said. "After the death of my husband many people encouraged me and prayed for me. God has sent you when I was distressed to comfort and support me... May God give an eternal dwelling in His kingdom to those who prayed for me and made this support to me and my children possible."
