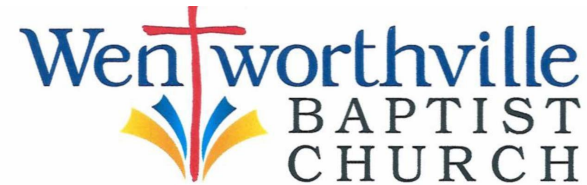
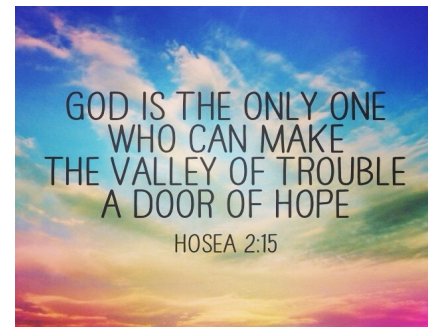

Mick & Tara have begun to prepare for their upcoming Home Assignment in Australia and are challenged by the temptation to detach themselves from where they are in SE Asia and focus on their other home, Australia. Mick's Language nurturer has been asking questions this past week about life and what the Bible says about it. Mick has been thankful that these have been natural and authentic conversations. The Education Foundation has been trialling a children's English program for primary age children. This is something the local community has been asking for.

Bek is travelling this month for a conference in amongst a very busy time as a Yawo team with various visitors to the area.

Glenn continues to teach English to 5 classes each week which has allowed him to be able to connect with their neighbours as the local people can visibly see that they are helping the community. They are thankful to have found a place to rent when they move to join the rural team. The team are in need of a Home School teacher to help our team to focus on language learning and building relationships. **Luke and Belle** are thankful for continued return of good health for Salem after spending some time in hospital recently fighting an infection. They are also celebrating the news that they are expecting a baby boy next year.
